



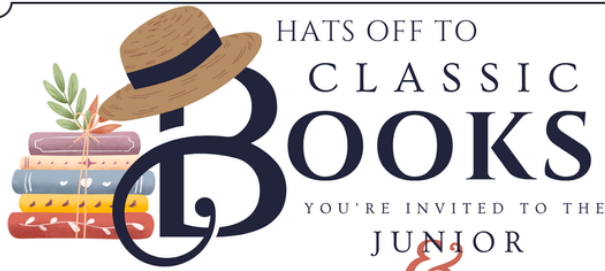

Click on **ORDER SCHOOL LUNCH**

Click on **CREATE AN ACCOUNT**

Once you **CREATE AN ACCOUNT**

Order by clicking on **ORDER.**

The lunches will be shown in rolling calendar format.

For further instruction, please click through the tutorials found at the left side.

ORDERING cutoff time is 9pm the night before the meal.

To get started, click on STUDENT.

Use the name your student is most familiar with.

Once you have added your student(s), you are ready to order.

You will be choosing the lunch choices every day.

Select your meals for the week / month

Click on the green **ADD TO CART**

There is a separate calendar for each student so you must toggle to each student and choose lunches before checking out.

This will allow you to purchase all lunches for multiple students in one transaction.

If your student will be absent, you must remove the paid meal online before 9pm the day before the meal or 8am, the day of the meal. Parents can **EMAIL OR TEXT** us to remove the meal.
